Minutes for the Meeting held

October 18, 2018

Call to Order:

The October meeting of the Mainville Sportsman Club was called to order by President Jaskiewicz at 7:05 p.m. with 21 members and 1 guest present. Club officers present were Denny Jaskiewicz, Curt Moorhead, and Joyce Lingousky. A moment of silence was observed and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Approval of Meeting Minutes:

The minutes of the September 20, 2018 minutes were read. A motion was made by Rich Winand and seconded by Roe Winand to approve the minutes as read. The motion carried.

Treasurer's Report:

Curt Moorhead presented the Treasurer's report in Karen Hunsinger's absence. The Treasurer's report for October showed a checking account balance as of October 18th, 2018 of \$28,097.72 with expenditures since last month of \$5968.07 and deposits of \$2584.23. Membership dues and land fees to date stand at \$31,849.00. A motion was made by Linda Snyder to approve the report as presented. The motion was seconded by Mary Ellen Moorhead. The motion carried.

President's Report:

Denny Jaskiewicz reported that the trap is up and running. Trap shoots will be 1 p.m. Saturdays. President Jaskiewicz also reported that the factory rep for the gate proposed installing a wireless transmitter to avoid continued lightning problems. The installed cost would be \$482 and could be installed in the coming week. A motion to approve the expenditure was made by Jim Cunningham and seconded by Rich Winand. The motion carried.

President Jaskiewicz also reminded members that sight-in Sunday is November 11th and the public is invited.

Committee Reports:

The only committee with a report for the month was the Steel Committee which had a shoot on October 7 that turned in \$50.
